

Resolution 13-09

Approval of The Manufacturing Technology Program

Whereas, Section 122 of the Workforce Investment Act provides definition of the requirements for the identification of eligible providers of training services.

Further, Section 663, Subpart E and Sections 663.500 and 663.505 address the responsibility of local workforce boards to establish eligibility for the provision of training services under WIA.

Whereas, all training to be provided under WIA must be in in-demand occupations as identified by the New York State Department of Labor Division of Research and Statistics and the local plan.

Whereas, the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Investment Board has received a properly completed proposal submission from BOCES for the new Manufacturing Technology Program.

Whereas, the Jefferson-Lewis WIB has received additional funding through the North Country Regional Economic Development Council for 2014 to assist the long-term unemployed in receiving training through this newly established training.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Investment Board hereby approves the training at BOCES of the Manufacturing Technology Program and it has been identified as an occupation in demand.
