

## **RESOLUTION 13-11**

### **Approval of Modification of Individual Training Account**

**Whereas**, the Section 134 (d) (4) (ii) and 663.430 (a) of the Workforce Investment Act establishes Individual Training Accounts for eligible individuals to finance training services,

**Whereas**, Section 663.420 of the Workforce Investment Act provides that The Local Board may impose limits on Individual Training Accounts,

**Whereas**, individuals requesting occupational skills training will be capped at \$500.00

**Whereas**, the maximum amount to be allocated to any one individual will be \$3,000.00 for both Classroom Training and On-the-Job Training for Program Year 2011 and beyond. Only payments for tuition, books and required fees, as long as it doesn't exceed the ITA Cap, will be paid.

#### **Supportive Services:**

**Whereas**, continued decreases in WIA program allocations and increased customer demand for program funding exist,

**Whereas**, SEC 134 (G) (e) (2) allows for supportive services whenever funding allows,

**Therefore, be it resolved** that the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Investment Board will not be offering supportive services to individuals and that Individual Training Accounts for both Classroom Training and On-the-Job Training will be capped at \$3,000.00 and no supportive services will be provided.
