- \_\_\_\_\_ Youth Overcoming Odds Provide information that describes how the nominee has made significant improvement that represents a long term behavioral or attitude change for the better and/or how the youth has overcome a family or personal difficulty and is succeeding in his or her personal goals. **Note:** confidential information will not be made public, but will be read by reviewers.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Youth Leadership Provide information that describes how the young person has been involved in leadership roles in the school or community and the impact of the leadership on other young people, the school or the community.

**ADULT/BUSINESS/ORGANIZATION Categories**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Outstanding Adult Youth Worker Provide information that describes the individual's paid employment in the youth service (including child welfare and juvenile justice), recreation, or education field and the impact of his or her work on youth, families and/or the community.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Promising Ability in Youth Services Provide information that describes how the individual has shown outstanding ability and has demonstrated a commitment to a career working with young people. The nominee must have entered the youth service, recreation, or education field within the last three years.
- \_\_\_\_\_ It Takes A Community Provide information that describes how the adult, (not employed in the youth service, education or recreation field) business or organization has shown outstanding commitment to bettering the lives of young people or families.

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Please provide enough information so that the reviewers will have a clear picture of the nominee's accomplishments. **We have found that it is important to hear directly from those who are familiar with the nominee's work and efforts**, so please feel free to include **up to 3** letters of support from others who are familiar with the nominee's activities, or who may have benefitted from involvement with the nominee.
