Whereas, By Resolution 204 of 2002, this Board increased the tipping fee for residential solid waste from \$100 to \$120 per ton, effectively \$76 per ton in addition to the tipping fee in effect at the DANC's Solid Waste Management Facility, and
Whereas, The current fees do not cover the costs of the transfer service, and
Whereas, This Board approved a pick-up fee for municipal recyclables of \$50 per pick-up, and
Whereas, It is the desire of the County to more accurately capture the costs of solid waste and recycling administration, and the adopted 2023 County Budget assumes fee increases.
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That effective January 1, 2023, the transfer fee for municipal solid waste received at the County solid waste transfer station from Commercial Waste Permit holders will be \$30 per ton in addition to the tipping fee in effect at the DANC Solid Waste Management Facility, and be it further
Resolved, That effective January 1, 2023, the transfer fee for residential solid waste will be \$80 per ton in addition to the tipping fee in effect at the DANC Solid Waste Management Facility, and be it further
Resolved, That effective January 1, 2023, the municipal recyclable pick-up fee will be \$75 per pick-up.
