Whereas, The Jefferson County Office for the Aging (OFA) works for the establishment and expansion of programs and services which assist older persons in the areas of their most urgent needs, and
Whereas, OFA is eligible to receive State and Federal funds for the purpose of providing such needed programs and services to elderly residents of Jefferson County, and
Whereas, OFA and this Board of Legislators desire to continue to contract for the provision of personal care services to the elderly.
