Whereas, Jefferson County Board of Legislators is committed to providing a high quality of services to the citizens of Jefferson County and the administrative employees of the County are one of the essential elements required to fulfill this commitment, and

Whereas, It is desirable to utilize the professional services of a consultant experienced in such compensation analysis, and as a result of a request for proposals, Burke Group is recommended.
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That Jefferson County enter into an agreement with Burke Group for performance of a compensation study of Management and Confidential positions at a cost of \$10,000, and be it further

LOCAL LAW INTRO NO 4 OF 2023

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1994 TO INCREASE THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY LEGISLATORS TO FOUR YEARS AND TO MODIFY THE PROCEDURES FOR THE REAPPORTIONMENT OF THE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Jefferson as follows:

Section I. <u>LEGISLATIVE INTENT</u>

At a referendum held during the General Election of the year 1994, by a majority of the votes cast, and a greater number of the votes than were cast in favor of an alternative proposition, the voters of Jefferson County approved Plan B (Section III) of Local Law No. 2 of 1994 (hereinafter also referred to as "Plan B") establishing a Board of Legislators as the governing and legislative board of the County of Jefferson. Plan B provides that the Board of Legislators shall be comprised of fifteen members, known as "County Legislators", with each member being elected from a single-member legislative district, each member serving a term of two years, and each member casting a single vote on all matters before the Board requiring a vote.

Plan B requires the reapportionment of the Board of Legislators according to the final report of each Federal decennial or special census detailing the number and location of inhabitants within the boundaries of the County of Jefferson, its respective towns and cities. Plan B further requires such a reapportionment to be implemented effective the next general election in November of the odd-numbered year next succeeding the receipt of the final census report and enactment of the reapportionment by the Board of Legislators.

Municipal Home Rule Law § 10(1)(a)(1) authorizes counties to set the term of office for their officers. Municipal Home Rule Law § 23(2)(e) provides that local laws changing the term of an elective office shall be subject to mandatory referendum. It is the intention of the Board of Legislators to employ the powers granted by Municipal Home Rule Law § 10(1)(a)(1), subject to mandatory referendum, to amend Plan B so as to: (a) increase the term of office of County Legislators to four years; and (b) modify the reapportionment procedures in Plan B to coincide with the change to a four year term of office.

SECTION II. AMENDMENT OF PLAN B

- A. Subdivision D of Section III of Local Law No. 2 of 1994 is hereby amended as follows:
 - D. The election of County Legislators shall take place at the General election held in every other odd-numbered year, commencing with the General Election in November 2025. County Legislators shall hold office for an elected term of four years to commence on the 1st day of January next succeeding the General election

at which elected. Vacancies in the office of County Legislator shall be filled in accordance with applicable provisions of controlling statutes, local laws, or charter as the case may be.

- B. Subdivision E of Section III of Local Law No. 2 of 1994 is hereby amended as follows:
 - E. The Board of Legislators shall be reappointed according to the final report of each federal decennial or special census detailing the number and location of the population within the boundaries of the County of Jefferson, and its respective towns and cities. The Board of Legislators shall, by local law, enact a plan to reapportion the Board of Legislators as soon as practicable following receipt of the final report of the decennial or special census, as the case may be. Such a local law enacting a plan for reapportionment shall be subject to referendum pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law. A plan of reapportionment enacted hereunder shall be effective for the election of County Legislators for the term of office immediately following the term of office of the Board of Legislators enacting the plan.
- C. All other provisions of Section III of Local Law No. 2 of 1994 not amended hereby, as the same may have been otherwise amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III. REFERENDUM AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall be submitted to referendum at the General Election to be held on November 7, 2023 and shall take effect upon approval by the electors voting at the said General election and filing in accordance with New York Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
