The appointment of Michael Crowley to the Board of Trustees of Jefferson Community College expires June 30, 2023. Mr. Crowley was initially appointed in June 2008 to fill the unexpired term of Martin P. Schatz. He was reappointed to a full seven-year term in June 2009, and elected again in June 2016.

For the past fifteen years, Mr. Crowley has been an active, committed and valued member of the Board. He has provided leadership to the Board, first as Vice Chair from 2010-2011 and then as Chair from 2012-2013. Whereas, A Request for Proposals was issued by the Purchasing Department at the request of the County Sheriff for comprehensive healthcare services for the Jefferson County Correctional Facility, and

Whereas, The Sheriff has recommended Primecare Medical of New York as the preferred provider of said services for an initial term of three years starting October 1, 2023, with the possibility of extending for up to two additional one-year terms, and

Whereas, The first year cost will be no more than \$2,705,858 plus pass through operational costs estimated at \$226,000, the second and third year increases of 3% each year, and the possible extensions under the same terms and conditions, and

Whereas, The said contracted services will replace existing medical-related Jail positions.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That Jefferson County enter into an agreement with Primecare Medical of New York for said services for the period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2026 with the option of two one-year extensions if approved by both parties as noted above, and be it further

Resolved, That the positions of Jail Physician (3150-045), Physician's Assistant (3150-066 & -073), and Registered Professional Nurse (3150-074, -076, -094 & -095), be deleted effective October 1, 2023, and be it further

Resolved, That the Chairman of the Board of Legislators is hereby authorized to execute such agreement on behalf of the County subject to the approval of the County Attorney as to form and content, and be it further
