Designating a Certifying Officer for the 2023 Community Development Block Grant Housing Application

Whereas, By Resolution 125 of 2023, the Board of Legislators authorized the submission of an application to the NYS Office for Community Renewal (OCR) for a 2023 Community Development Block Grant, and
Whereas, Jefferson County will apply for a grant from the NYS OCR through its 2023 Community Development Block Grant program to fund a housing rehabilitation program to benefit income eligible homeowners throughout Jefferson County, and
Whereas, The Board of Legislators agrees to comply with all state and federal regulations that are applicable to that funding, and
Whereas, In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and the related authorities listed at 24 CFR Part 58 the County is required to conduct an Environmental Review before grant award funds are released, and
Whereas, The NYS Office of Community Renewal, as the agency responsible for administering HUD funding in New York State, requires that local communities administering programs with that funding must designate a Certifying Officer with authority to monitor compliance with the environmental review process.
Now, Therefore Be it Resolved, That Michael J. Bourcy, Director of the Jefferson County Department of Planning is hereby appointed as Certifying Officer for Jefferson County with authority to monitor compliance with 24 CFR Part 58 of the federal regulations, and be it further
