Whereas, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act dated July 1, 2014, Section 107 (g) (2) requires local areas to select an operator through a competitive process; and

Whereas, the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Development Area contracted with New York Association of Training and Employment Professionals, known as NYATEP to issue the Request for Proposals (RFP) to avoid any conflict of interest and through this process awarded Jefferson County Department of Employment & Training the One Stop Operator Agreement from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

Whereas, the RFP calls to review the agreement on a yearly basis; and
