SECTIONS 6301 AND 6305 OF THE EDUCATION LAW, IN CONNECTION WITH ATTENDANCE AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Education Law, Section 6305, provides: "The chief fiscal officer of each county, as defined in section 2.00 of the local finance law, shall, upon application and submission to him of satisfactory evidence, issue to any person is a resident of said county...Such person shall, upon his registration for each college year, file with the college such a certificate of residence issued not earlier than two months prior thereto, and such certificate of residence shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance. Education Law, Section 6301, paragraph 4, defines "Resident." A person who has resided in the state for a period of at least one year and in the county, city, town, intermediate school district, as the case may be, for period of at least six months, both immediately preceding the date of such person's registration in a community college or, for the purposes of section sixty-three hundred five of this chapter, his application for a certificate of residence.

In the event that a person qualified as above for state resident, but has been a resident two or more counties in the state during the six months immediately preceding his application for a certificate of residence pursuant to section 6305 of this chapter, the charges to the counties of residence shall be allocated amount eh several counties proportional to the number of months, or major fraction thereof, of residence in each county.
