# BID #2021F-7 TOWING AND RECOVERY SERVICES DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

#### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

To provide towing and recovery services for Jefferson County's fleet of vehicles and equipment and as required by the various County Departments, including the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office.

The County currently has a fleet of approximately 300 vehicles and miscellaneous types of motorized equipment.

### 2. REQUIREMENTS

Vendor shall be licensed and registered to include Tow Endorsement on their license and be able to provide proof of the same if requested.

All Tow Vehicles shall be plainly identified on the vehicle as per New York State Law.

All fees shall not exceed any County, State or Federal regulations regarding towing services and charges.

Towing and mileage estimates shall be for evaluation purposes only and may be more or less depending on the needs of the County.

Vendor shall be required to be available and in compliance with the terms and conditions of this agreement seven days per week, 24 hours per day including holidays and weekends.

Vendors shall be required to provide towing services for vehicles based on the Towing and Recovery Vehicle Identification Guide (TRAA) which can be found as part of this specification.

## 3. PRICING

Vendor must submit pricing based on each category as identified on the bid pages which follow.

### 4. AWARD

Award will be made to the vendor offering the lowest overall cost for all categories.

An award will be made to both a primary and secondary provider based on lowest and 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest overall cost.

## 5. INVOICING

All invoices shall be sent to the individual department requiring services and shall be invoiced in accordance with the awarded pricing within 30 days of the service date. Each invoice shall state category and hours.
