

DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

CONTRACT PRICE ADJUSTMENTS

All prices submitted must remain firm for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of award. Beginning September 1, 2023 subsequent price adjustments will be considered by the County. All requests for price adjustments must be submitted to the County a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the date of the requested price adjustment. The change in price structure (increase or decrease) must be based on fluctuations in the latest published Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all urban consumers, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics which is available at <https://stats.bls.gov>.

If, during the Contract term, the awarded vendor is unable to meet contractual requirements in whole or in part based on the price structure of the contract, it shall immediately notify the County in writing. The County may, but is not required to, consider an adjustment in the contract terms and/or pricing.

Should the County in its sole discretion determine during the Contract term that the contract price structure results in prices which are unreasonable, excessive, or not truly reflective of current market conditions, and no adjustment in the contract terms and/or pricing is mutually agreeable, the County may terminate the contract through written notice to the vendor, purchase from an alternate source, or rebid the contract.

PART I

CURBING FOR PROJECTS AND MAINTENANCE

Jefferson County solicits bids to furnish at specified sites, conventionally formed or machine formed concrete curbing, or granite curbing for various projects.

GENERAL NOTES

The County seeks a unit price per foot to supply all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the work in compliance with the most recent *Standard Specifications for Construction and Materials* of the New York State Department of Transportation and addenda. Payments shall be made for requested services or materials measured in Customary US units.

DESCRIPTION OF ITEM

Curbing is to be installed to the lines and grades given in the project drawings.

Trenching and general grading required for this work shall be performed by the Owner or the Owner's subcontractor. Minor grading required for fine grading shall be performed by the curbing Contractor. All concrete finishing work shall be performed by the curbing Contractor to the line and grade depicted on the plans and the standard sheets. Paving, top soiling and seeding will be performed by others.

QUALIFICATION OF FIRM

No response will be considered for award unless the firm submitting the response can meet the following conditions:

- a. The firm, at the time of the response, must have at least five years experience in repair or replacement of concrete or granite curbing for the State of New York and its political subdivisions. Each operator, supervisor, and foreman shall have equivalent experience.
- b. The bidder shall possess a current and valid license to conduct business in the State of New York.

The Contractor is to supply all labor, small tools, transportation, goods, and supplies to properly execute the work as described herein. The written purchase order will describe the location, type of curbing material, depths, widths and yield required.

#2023h-16 – CURBING, CONCRETE PIPE, AND PRECAST CONCRETE DRAINAGE UNITS

The Contractor shall perform all work in a workmanlike manner with due regard to the safety and health of the employees and of the public, in full compliance with the provisions of all applicable laws. The Contractor shall be responsible for traffic control in full compliance with the provisions of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. All work shall be completed without environmental damage to any stream, body of water or drinking water source and be in conformance with the provisions of the County's Memorandum of Understanding with the NYSDEC or any permits issued by the DEC or the Army Corps of Engineers.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The unit price bid shall include the cost of furnishing all labor, (including any supplements, holidays, or other "fringes"), equipment, materials, small tools, transportation and goods and supplies necessary to complete the work as specified.

GENERAL: All materials furnished must comply with the detailed requirements of the most recent New York State Department of Transportation material. Pipe will be fabricated to conform to material specifications of section 706-02, 706-03, or 706-04 as required.

BASIS OF ACCEPTANCE: Reinforced Concrete pipe will be accepted on the basis of certification of quality assurance performed by the manufacturer as provided in section 706-02 3)A) (2) Production Testing.

The sizes listed in the following table are to be furnished as required by the County. Quantities listed are for determination of low gross bid only, actual quantities may vary. Price bid is per lineal foot of pipe.

DELIVERY: Delivery shall be made via truck within twenty one (21) days after purchase order is given. Delivery is to be designated job site within Jefferson County, to County Highway complex, or to any Town Garage within the County. Prices quoted shall be F.O.B. job site or County Garage. A twenty-four (24) hour notice prior to delivery will be made to the ordering agency.

Part III PRECAST CONCRETE DRAINAGE UNITS

SCOPE: This specification covers the material and fabrication for Precast Drop Inlets and Transverse Drainage Interceptor Units.

GENERAL: All material furnished under this contract must comply with the detailed requirements of the most recent New York State Department of Transportation Material Specifications.

Drainage Structures. Materials used for the construction of drainage structures shall conform to the requirements of the following:

Transverse Drainage Interceptors. Materials used for transverse drainage interceptors shall meet the requirements of §604-2.02.01, except that bar reinforcement shall meet the requirements of §709-04, Epoxy Coated Bar Reinforcement, Grade 60. Precast transverse drainage interceptors shall meet the requirements of §706-04, Precast Concrete Drainage Units. Dowels shall be fabricated from epoxy coated bar reinforcement conforming to §709-04.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Concrete Drainage Structures and Manholes shall be constructed in accordance with section 604-3.02 of the current edition of the requirements of these specifications, the Standard Sheets and plans. Precast drainage structures shall be constructed of Class A Concrete and to the requirements of Section 555 Structural Concrete. Vendor proposed changes to drainage structures shown on the Standard Sheets or on the plans, other than minor changes approved by the Engineer, shall require submission of complete working drawings to the Engineer for review and approval.

Pipe Entries. All pipe(s) built into the wall(s) of a drainage structure shall be flush with the inside face of the drainage structure wall and shall project outside a sufficient distance to allow connection with the adjoining section. The wall knockouts and sealing the space around the pipe shall be in accordance with the Standard Sheets. The bell of concrete pipe shall be cut off at every pipe entry where the bell enters the drainage structure.

Frames and Grates: The precast drainage units shall be capable of accepting Standard sized NYSDoT Rectangular grates and frames or cast frames and curb boxes, which will be obtained through a separate bid item.

Concrete Covers: Precast concrete covers shall be fabricated as provided in the standard sheets.

Transverse Drainage Interceptors: This work shall consist of the construction of reinforced concrete transverse drainage interceptors with frames and grates, and dowels as shown on the plans or Standard Sheets.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

Drainage Structures. Precast drainage units will be measured for payment by the number of linear feet of height measured to the nearest tenth of a foot from the bottom of the base to the top of the masonry, including the top slab.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

Drainage Structures. The unit price bid per linear foot shall include the cost of all labor, equipment and materials, including bar reinforcement and welded wire fabric, necessary to provide the product

Frames, Covers and Grates. Frames and grates will be paid for under the appropriate payment items for Frames and Grates in Item 14.

Precast concrete covers will be paid for individually at the unit price provided in this item.

Transverse Drainage Interceptors. The price per linear foot bid for this work shall include the cost of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to supply the transverse Drainage interceptors

BASIS OF ACCEPTANCE: Precast concrete drainage units will be accepted by certification of quality assurance testing performed by the manufacturer as in "1. Production Testing" as described in the NYSDoT Material Specification Item 706-04. The precast concrete drainage unit shall be shipped once the compressive strength requirement is attained.

The sizes listed in table following are to be furnished as required. Openings in Drop Inlet Walls will be cast in as specified with each order. Quantities required may vary due to circumstances, however, price on one (1) foot length times quantity required will determine gross sum bid. Low gross sum bid will determine successful bidder.

DELIVERY: Delivery shall be made via truck within twenty one (21) days after order is given. Delivery will be to designated job site, within Jefferson County, to County Garage Grounds, or to any Town Garage within the County. Prices quoted shall be F.O.B. job site or County Highway Department. A twenty-four (24) hour notice prior to delivery will be made to the ordering agency. Friday deliveries are not taken from May through September.

Contractor hereby represents that said Contractor is in compliance with New York State General Municipal Law Section 103-g entitled “Iranian Energy Sector Divestment”, in that said Contractor has not:

Except as otherwise specifically provided herein, every Contractor submitting a bid in response to this Request for Bids must certify and affirm the following under penalties of perjury:

- a. “By submission of this bid, each Bidder and each person signing on behalf of any Bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid, each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief, that each Bidder is not on the list created pursuant to NYS Finance Law Section 165-a (3)(b).”

Jefferson County will accept this statement electronically in accordance with the provisions of Section 103 of the General Municipal Law.

Except as otherwise specifically provided herein, any Bid that is submitted without having complied with subdivision (a) above, shall not be considered for award. In any case where the Bidder cannot make the certification as set forth in subdivision (a) above, the Bidder shall so state and shall furnish with the bid a signed statement setting forth in detail the reasons therefore. The County reserves its rights, in accordance with General Municipal Law Section 103-g to award the Bid to any Bidder who cannot make certification, on a case-by-case basis under the following circumstances.

1. The investment activities in Iran were made before April 12, 2012, the investment activities in Iran have not been expanded or renewed after April 12, 2012, and the Bidder has adopted, publicized and is implementing a formal plan to cease the investment activities in Iran and to refrain from engaging in any new investments in Iran; or
2. The County of Jefferson has made a determination that the goods or services are necessary for the County to perform its functions and that, absent such an exemption, the County of Jefferson would be unable to obtain the goods or services for which the Bid is offered. Such a determination shall be made by the County in writing and shall be a public document.
