

YMCA Emergency Childcare Brief

March 23, 2020

All YMCA Childcare Programs are fully licensed programs under the NYS Office of Children and Families. Strict COVID 19 screening procedures are in place that must be followed at the site prior to the child entering care each day. Space is limited and is available to essential workers only.

1. Emergency Childcare for School Aged Children in K-6

- a. Hours - 6:30 am – 6 pm
- b. Rates per child (discount for second child):
 - i. 3 Day: \$119/week
 - ii. 5 Day: \$178/week
 - iii. One day- emergency use only \$67
- c. Sites are all located at the following Jefferson County schools:
 - i. Watertown – HS, Wiley, North Elementary
 - ii. Evans Mills Elementary
 - iii. Sackets Harbor Central
 - iv. Brownville Middle School
 - v. Carthage Elementary
 - vi. Black River Elementary
 - vii. Wilson Elementary (South Jefferson School District)
 - viii. Clayton Elementary

2. Emergency Daycare – Children 6 weeks to Pre-k

- a. Hours – 6:30 am – 5:30 pm
- b. Rates (all weekly rates)
 - i. Infant: \$222/week
 - ii. Toddler: \$213/week
 - iii. 3's: \$202/week
 - iv. 4's: \$202/week
- c. Site – YMCA Daycare Center 514 Washington Street, Watertown, NY 13601

Enrollment forms must be complete and received by 12 noon the day before the care is needed to start. (Friday at 12 noon for Monday care).
