

Resolution 15-11

Approval of Youth Services Providers

Whereas, the provisions of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (Public Law 105-220) require certain program elements for the delivery of youth services under Title 1B of the Act to be competitively procured,

Whereas, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (Public Law 113-128) requires program elements for the delivery of youth services under Title 113 of the Act to be competitively procured, and

Whereas, the local Workforce Development Area complied with the provisions of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act by the placement of legal notices in area newspapers advertising the availability of the local Youth Request for Proposal (RFP), beginning on May 29, 2015 and posted on social media sites, and

Whereas, the local area received one proposal for comprehensive youth services by the June 15, 2015 deadline date, and

Whereas, it is recommended to the Workforce Development Board that the following entities have submitted proposals that provide program elements in the delivery of comprehensive youth services that are appropriate for funding under Title 1B of WIOA, now

Therefore, be it resolved that the Workforce Development Board does hereby approve the youth service providers listed below for Program year 2015 (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016) at the indicated funding levels:

Jefferson County Department of Employment & Training: \$160,000.00

Lewis County Department of Employment & Training: \$40,000.00
