Approval of the Integrated Production & Design Technology Program

Whereas, Section 122 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act provides definition of the requirements for the identification of eligible providers of training services.

Whereas, Section 107, addresses the responsibility of local workforce boards to establish eligibility for the provision of training services under WIOA.

Whereas, all training to be provided must be in demand occupations as identified by the local plan.

Whereas, the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Development Board (WDB) has received a properly completed proposal submission from BOCES for the new Integrated Production and Design Technology Program to be held at the Howard G.
