Resolution 17-18

Priority of Service Policy

Whereas, WIOA Section 134(c)(3)(E) and Federal Register Part VIII, Department of Labor, Veteran' Employment and Training Service, 20 CFR Part 1010, Final Rule, RIN 1293-AA15, (12/19/08) both require Priority of Service for covered persons, and

Whereas, the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Development Board seeks to maintain current policies, and

Whereas, priority of service shall be applied in the following order when two or more individuals are requesting a service within the same time frame:

- 1) First, to veterans and eligible spouses who are also included in the groups given statutory priority for WIOA adult formula funds. This means that veterans and eligible spouses who are also recipients of public assistance, other low-income individuals, or individuals who are basic skills deficient would receive first priority for services provided with WIOA adult formula funds.
- 2) Second, to non-covered persons (that is, individuals who are not veterans or eligible spouses) who are included in the groups given priority for WIOA adult formula funds.
- 3) Third, to veterans and eligible spouses who are not included in WIOA's priority groups.
- 4) Last, to non-covered persons outside the groups given priority under WIOA.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Development Board does hereby approve the Priority of Service policy as listed above.
